Placing Text on a Button



1. Suppose this is our button.



2. Use the Type Tool [Press T]. Type the longest label of your button and change the size until it fits to the button. The example on the left doesn't look pleasing and kind of squeezing the words in the button.



3. The example on the left looks fine. It is not very easy to read but exactly placed on the button.



4. This one is OK. The technique is easy, use only Gothic text like Arial, Impact, Verdana or other fonts that has even in thickness. Do not use romans or script like **Times Roman** or other fonts that has thicks and thins.



5. Now type the shortest. Do not change the font size, they should be uniform. Since our button is so small we should use Gothic fonts for easy to read.



Others are trying to fit the word or words in the button which is not good.



Even it is so small, but readable.
